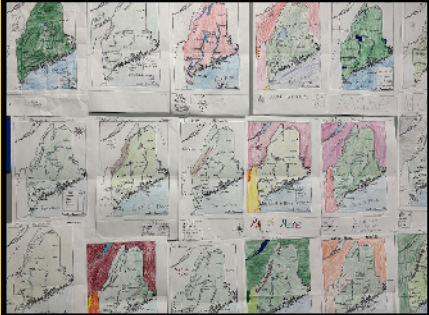
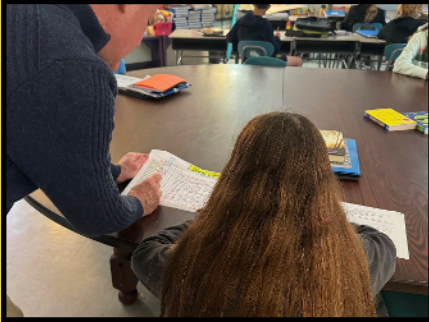


JAGUAR UPDATE - APR.26TH, 2024
