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SCIENCE

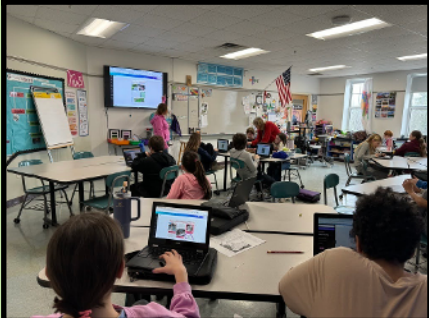
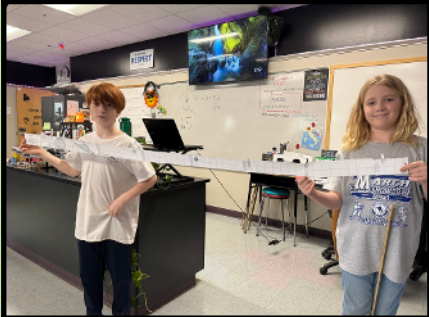
- How old they would be if they were to live either on Mercury or Jupiter.
