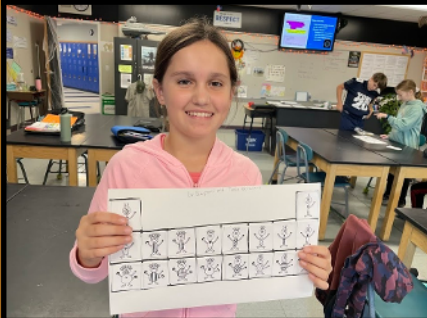


JAGUAR UPDATE - NOV 3RD, 2023
