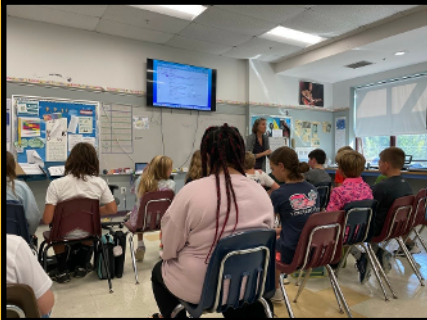
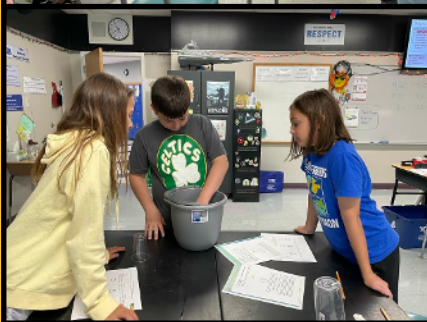
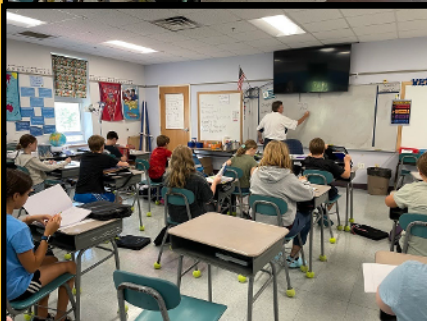


JAGUAR UPDATE - SEPT 13TH, 2023
